MCEC ANNUAL SPRING GATHERING:

The MCEC Spring Gathering is taking place at Club Roma in St.Catharines on Friday Evening **April 23rd** and during the day on Saturday, **April 24th**. MENNONITE CENTRAL COMMITTEE:

Haiti Update: We are excited to report that the first container of MCC canned meat, 1000 water filters and accompanying water buckets have been delivered to people in Haiti. A shipment of inventoried relief kits have also been delivered to Haiti, and we are approaching 2000 relief kits here in Ontario. MCC continues to welcome financial and material donations. For the latest updates on MCC's response in Haiti, visit <http://mcc.org/haitiearthquake/news>. **In addition**, MCC is asking for donations of 20,000 relief kits, 10,000 heavy comforters and 10,000 sheets (queen-size, double, or king) for shipment now through Feb. 28.

MCC: Haiti Earthquake Material Aid Response

Relief kit contents: (individual items or whole kit)

- 4 large bars bath soap (leave in wrapping)
- 1 plastic bottle shampoo (380-710ml); place bottle in a resealable plastic bag)
- 4 large bars of laundry soap ** this item has become increasingly hard to find. Bulk Barn carries a limited supply. If you can't find it, bring your kits without it; we will add the laundry soap bars from our own supply at the Kitchener warehouse
- 1 squeeze -tube toothpaste (minimum 130 ml; leave in box)
- 4 adult-size toothbrushes (leave in packaging)
- 4 new bath towels (medium weight, dark or bright colours)
- 2 wide-tooth combs (15 to 20 cm)
- 1 fingernail clipper
- 1 box adhesive bandages (minimum 40, assorted)
- 1 package sanitary pads (18-24 thin maxi)

Supplies Drop off supplies at the church in the lower foyer by the Missions bulletin board. MCC will pack kit items in 5-gallon pails at their warehouse.

Sheet details: New, double -, queen- or king-size, flat sheets.

- 300 thread count or higher. Cotton, light colours

Heavy blankets: these can be the hand knotted comforters or purchased heavy blankets. The reason for heavier weight blankets is that people are sleeping outside on the ground and heavyweight blankets provide more warmth in those conditions.

Sermon Series: “Being the church”

In the last sermon series “Why Church”, we explored who **belongs** to the church (everyone who accepts Jesus’ offer of salvation), who we are **becoming** (continually transformed by Christ rather than conformed to the world), and our **purpose** (just as God sent Jesus into the world, so also Jesus sends us into the world).

Over the next few weeks as we move into the Lent season and prepare ourselves for Easter, we will look at the practical outworking of Christian community as taught by the Apostle Paul to the Christians in Rome. Romans 12 is an excellent teaching on how to experience the love that is at the heart of Christian community. The chapter begins by emphasizing the need to be transformed in our thinking (vs 2), and filled with genuine love (vs 9). In the verses 3-21 Paul fleshes both of those out as he teaches us how to relate to each other within community, as well as how to relate to the world at large.

In this series on “**Being the Church**” we will focus on the practical teachings of verses 9-13 where in a few concise phrases Paul tells us how we can be the church we are called to be, reminding us, as Marva Dawn notes, that...*“God loves us so much that he accepts us just as we are, but he also loves us too much to let us stay that way.”*
